EXPERIMENTAL POTATO CENTER TO BE OPENED

Growers and NYA to Conduct Reclamation Project on Mountain

COULDSBURG, Aug. 15 (AP)—An experimental agricultural work center established primarily in hope of reclamation of thousands of acres of scrub-covered mountain land for potato growing, will be dedicated Wednesday at Dunbar Hill, Water St. Center, near National Youth Administration director, announced today.

Formal opening of the center, to be called "Camp Potato," will be attended by state county and local officials, as well as 1,000 members of the Pennsylvania Cooperative Potato Growers Association, co-sponsor of the project. County and State Agricultural Department, assisted by the NYA and the potato growers association, will put the unencumbered grounds to work at the center under direction of Dr. E. R. Nixon, Pennsylvania State University pathologist, and Dr. F. Allison, NYA resident work center supervisor.

Camp Potato, which will define the line between scrub and agricultural potato, will be reclamation of every part of the center. Other resident work center projects were established earlier this summer at Big Pond, near Dunbar, and at Great Bend, Susquehanna County.
