WOMAN FATALLY HURT IN PLUNGE FROM PORCH ROOF

Successful
Mrs. Fred Kramer Seized With Attack of Vertigo While Cleaning Windows and Falls Fifteen Feet to Sidewalk—Dies Four Hours Later

Somed with an attack of vertigo while standing on a porch roof of her home yesterday afternoon at 2:30, Mrs. Carrie Hobbs Kramer, 501 South 2nd street, fell backward from the roof, landed on the pavement below and sustained injuries that proved fatal at 6:30 last evening.

Mrs. Kramer had been suffering with similar attacks for some time past and yesterday afternoon when she expressed a desire to clean the windows on the second floor of her home, which had to be done from the porch roof in front of the house, her husband implored her to wait until their next return home and have him do it for her.

However, she decided that she would do the work herself and a short time after she had stepped to the roof and was in the act of cleaning the windows when she was struck with the attack and plunged to the pavement below, a distance of 15 feet.

Mrs. Kramer standing near the house saw her wife plunge from the roof and immediately hurried to her aid.

She was unconscious upon her arrival and was bleeding from the mouth and a gash on the head.

Neighbors assisted her to the hospital where she was treated by a physician and died four hours later, after an examination revealed no broken bones. Death apparently was caused by an internal hemorrhage and shock.
